

Report for April 2022

I have not heard from the Village about the Parks Program or an HVAC estimate.

I anticipate continuing and additional staff shortages due to health issues. If the shortages take place mostly in July and August, our page may be able to take on additional hours and duties.

The Village arranged for us to be added to their new telephone system. We are no longer on the Verizon landline system. This is a web based VOIP system through another vendor. We also got new phones and it works with our current FAX/photocopier. The installer also provided us with training and a login to a website with instructions, help and some interesting configuration possibilities that I am still exploring. The upside is no more static on the line. The down side is if the Internet is down, the phone line is down..

We are resuming visits from kindergarten classes from the New York Mills School District in collaboration with the school librarian, Danielle Howe. On Friday, May 13 in the morning, the school will bus over the teachers and children, one class at a time (there are 2 classes.) Ms. Howe took Youth Registration Forms for the parents to fill out and will get them back to me a few days before the visit so we can hand out library cards to the children. Usually I read a book or two and answer questions. The first class has requested no snacks and the second class will get snacks.

The Mid-York Library System Road Trip program starts on Memorial Day and goes to Labor Day. I will email the link to a website as soon as it goes live. This program is organized and funded by Mid-York and will have a low impact on staff time.
